- **A. Discipleship Needed:** Christianity must reproduce, expand and conquer.
- **B. Discipleship Explained:** Follow up of new believers and development of saints.
- **C. Discipleship Understood:** Biblical maturing is essential to the church.

KEY ISSUES

I. Personal Interest:

- 1. Love others with personal commitment.
- 2. Anticipate problems and offer solutions.
- 3. Vision for their future and potential.

II. Positive Action:

- 1. Critical follow up...The child must grow.
- 2. Personal attention....one on one is impressive.
- 3. Planned proven system of organized follow up.

III. Punctual Contact:

- 1. Keep in touch....no substitute for personal reoccurring attention given.
- 2. Chart their progress....encourage and direct.
- 3. Repeated guidance....address weaknesses...commend strengths.

IV. Provide Materials:

- 1. Bible and good literature for study.
- 2. Promote reading and memorization of scripture.
- 3. Recommend a good church.

V. Preserve Converts:

- 1. Continued friendship and guidance.
- 2. Maintain personal interest...they must not fall through the cracks.
- 3. Keep them focused and growing.

VI. Promote service:

- 1. Teach them how to reproduce.
- 2. Challenge them to start on their friends and relatives.
- 3. Get them involved and working for God.

VII. Provide Accountability:

- 1. Have them pick a Godly friend.
- 2. Become active in a good church.
- 3. Set up accountability with others.

Perpetuating Christianity:

- 1. We all share in the responsibility. Mark 16:15
- 2. Time is getting short. Eph. 5:16
- 3. The dividends are out of this world.

REACHING OUR OWN PERSONAL DISCIPLESHIP

Conditions of Discipleship:

(1). THERE MUST BE A HATING:

"If anyone come after me and hate not father and mother and brother and sister and self he cannot be my disciple" Luke 14:26.

Translate "hate" as love-less...Christ must be first in our love.

(2). THERE MUST BE A CROSS BEARING:

"Whosoever does not bear his cross and come after me cannot be my disciple" Luke 14:27. True discipleship requires hardship, discipline and perhaps death.

(3). THERE MUST BE A FORSAKING OF ALL:

"Whosoever forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple" Luke 14:33. We must be willing to "give up", "go" or "be" whatever He desires from us.

(4). A DENIAL OF SELF:

"Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself" Mark 8:34. Faithful service will always require personal sacrifice and discipline.

(5). FOLLOWING JESUS:

Take up his cross and follow me"

Christ must be your daily pattern with day by day obedience.
