I. The Causes:

- (1). Compromised association...."You can't run with a skunk and smell like a rose."
- (2). Watered down preaching..... Cowards in the pulpit allow pollution in the pew.
- (3). Weakened standards...... Allowing weakness compromises effectiveness.
- (4). Contemptible music...... Fleshly music encourages cheap living.
- (5). Congregational battles...... Shooting one's self in the foot is not wise.
- (6). Pastoral Inconsistencies...... Actions always speak louder than words.
- (7). Dearth of dedication...... Sloppy living results in sloppy surroundings.
- (8). Pace of today's living...... Believers have made themselves too busy.

II. The Road Back:

- (1). Prevailing prayer. Matt. 7:7&8 "Ask, seek, find."
- (2). Strong Biblical preaching. Isa. 58:1 "Cry aloud, shew my people their transgression."
- (3). Restore Bible standards. Amos 5:15 "Hate the evil, love the good, restore judgment."
- (4). Return to good music. Psm. 19:14 "Let the words of my mouth be acceptable."
- (5). Repair relationships. Matt. 5:24 " Be reconciled to thy brother."
- (6). Confession of sin. I John 1:9 "If we confess our sins."
- (7). Redefine purpose. John 15:16 "Chosen, ordained, bring forth fruit."
- (8) Adjust priorities. Matt. 6:33 "Seek ye first the kingdom of God."
- (9). Restore vision. Jer. 33:3 "Call unto me, great and mighty things."

III. Future Prevention:

(1). Diligent assessment. Psm. 51:18 "Create clean heart, renew right spirit."

(2). Prayer Emphasis. I Thess. 5:17 "Pray without ceasing."

(3). Love for Christ. Mark 12:30 "Love the Lord, heart, soul, mind, strength."

(4). Daily discipline. Rom. 12: 2 "Be not conformed, but transformed."

(5). Total Surrender. Rom. 12:1 "Present your bodies."

(6). Submission to others. Eph. 5:21 "One to another in the fear of God."

(7). Pursuit of holy things.
(8). Fearless preaching.
I Pet. 1:16 "Be ye holy for I am holy."
II Cor. 4:2 "Renounce the hidden things."

(9). Please Christ. II Tim. 2:4 " Please Him who hath chosen us to be soldiers."

(10). Pursue souls. Prov. 11:30 "He that winneth souls is wise."

(11). Busy in Service. I Cor. 15:58 "Always abounding in the work of the Lord.

(12). Keep looking up. Luke 21:28 "Lift up your heads, your redemption draweth nigh."
