WHERE DID IT GO?

Psalm 51:15 *“O Lord, open thou my lips; and my mouth shall shew forth thy praise.”* A few weeks ago, I awoke on Sunday morning to find that I barely had a voice. I started coming down with a cold on Saturday while we were traveling between meetings. I don't get colds often and when I do, they almost never affect my voice. However, this cold went straight for my vocal chords and caused a severe case of Laryngitis. The pastor preached the Sunday School hour. I managed to croak out the Sunday morning message. By Sunday evening, I had no voice at all, but I preached anyway with a microphone held to my mouth. Thankfully, a chalk drawing was scheduled for that night, so I only had to use my voice to preach, once again with a microphone to my mouth. There was no change Monday night so I did another chalk drawing in lieu of the normal puppets. I told the Lord that, like the little boy at the feeding of five thousand, I did not have much to offer, but all I had was His to use! On Tuesday night I did another chalk drawing. I began preaching with very little voice. As I went on, my voice began to return and by the end of the message, I



had about half of it back. It swiftly disappeared again after the service was over, but praise God for the provision to preach! By Wednesday night (the final service), my voice had mostly returned and I was able to do the puppets as well as preach. This was the first time in forty years of ministry that I lost my voice entirely for nearly the whole meeting. Cheryl was experiencing difficulty with her voice too, so it was also the only meeting in forty years in which we did no vocal specials! Thankfully, we were able to do piano and brass duets. I am glad that the people who attended the meetings were gracious enough to put up with my voice. Everyone was praying for me and God's grace to preach was evident. We praise the Lord for the decisions that were made among the believers and for the souls that were saved in the services!
