SUMMER VARIETY



Summer is a time of great variety for us. The various facets of the ministry the Lord has given us makes us very versatile for churches and camps. In the past few weeks, we have preached for a week of Junior camp, conducted a four day Family VBS, and preached a four day revival in a young church plant. In the next month we will be doing a six day Family VBS, and will be integrating our program with another church for a four day regular VBS which includes an adult class. Following that, we will be doing a six day revival meeting, and then a five day church Family Camp. We appreciate your prayers as we continue our Summer schedule.



GREAT VBS PROJECT

Vacation Bible School or "VBS" is an outreach that most churches have during the Summer. Many churches look for a worthy missions project toward which they can put their VBS offering. I would like to make a suggestion! A couple of months ago, I mentioned the great work that Eric and Stephanie



Chapman and the EurAsian Baptist Mission are doing with refugees from the war in Ukraine. (*Thanks to all of you who have given toward that ministry.*) While that work is still going on at Camp Hope in

Moldova, that venue is also where the Mission conducts Summer Bible camps. It is the first time in two years (*due to Covid*) that the Mission has been able to do so. I preached for the camp before there were trained Moldovans who could do it. This is a very fruitful ministry. So far this summer, there have been three weeks of camp. The first week was for 10-14 year olds. There were 220 campers and 194 salvation decisions! Last week was for teens in the Romanian language. There were 209 campers with 128 salvation decisions! This week is another week of teen camp, this time in the Russian language. It is too soon for any

reports of decisions yet. Some of these young people end up attending the Bible Institute and go on to serve the Lord in the ministry or in their local churches. There are still three more weeks of camp left this Summer. It costs \$40 for a camper to attend camp. The Mission requires each camper to pay half. The Mission is subsidizing the other half of the cost. **At \$20 each your VBS children would be excited about seeing how many young people in Moldova they can send to camp!** You can donate to the camp expenses at the Mission website: <https://www.eurasianbaptistmission.com/donate>.
