The church has grown since we were there last. They have their own building, but they rent a community center to accommodate the Sunday morning crowd. All other services were held in the church. God gave us four great days of ministry together. In addition to the services, we also were able to join in open air ministry one day. It is a great illustration of the reason we make international trips! We bring the ministry the Lord has given us along side the missionary to help them reach the lost! Calvary Baptist has a team that presents the gospel down town each week. They were excited to have us along. It was too windy to bring the puppet stage that day, but I did take a few of our ventriloguist puppets with us. I also took my horn and a tablet with Cheryl's piano accompaniments. We were able to use the



team's portable sound system. I played a few horn numbers, giving testimony in between each. That got people's attention. Then I did a gospel puppet presentation. Pastor said

he had never seen that many people gathered around the ministry team before. While I presented the gospel with music and ventriloquism, the team made their way though the crowd passing out tracts and witnessing. At one point, the whole team gathered to sing as I accompanied them on the horn. It was a blessed time. Pastor said it gave them more opportunities to witness to people who came to see what was going on. Thanks to your prayers, we saw souls saved every week of the trip!

We also appreciated those who prayed for our health! I caught a cold, the second day of the mission trip, that got progressively worse each day. Thankfully the Lord kept it from affecting my vocal chords. Cheryl caught the cold too going into the last week. By the time we finished the last service in Peterborough I had

accute bronchitis and Cheryl had congested lungs. When we arrived in the U.S. we had a week to get well before our first U.S. meetings of the year. We went to the doctor and got some medication. I sent out some texts asking God's people to pray. God answered prayer and got us back on our feet by the end of the week so we could leave on schedule. It has been two weeks now and Cheryl and I are pretty much over our illness thanks to those who prayed for us and most of all to the Great Physician!
